Locations

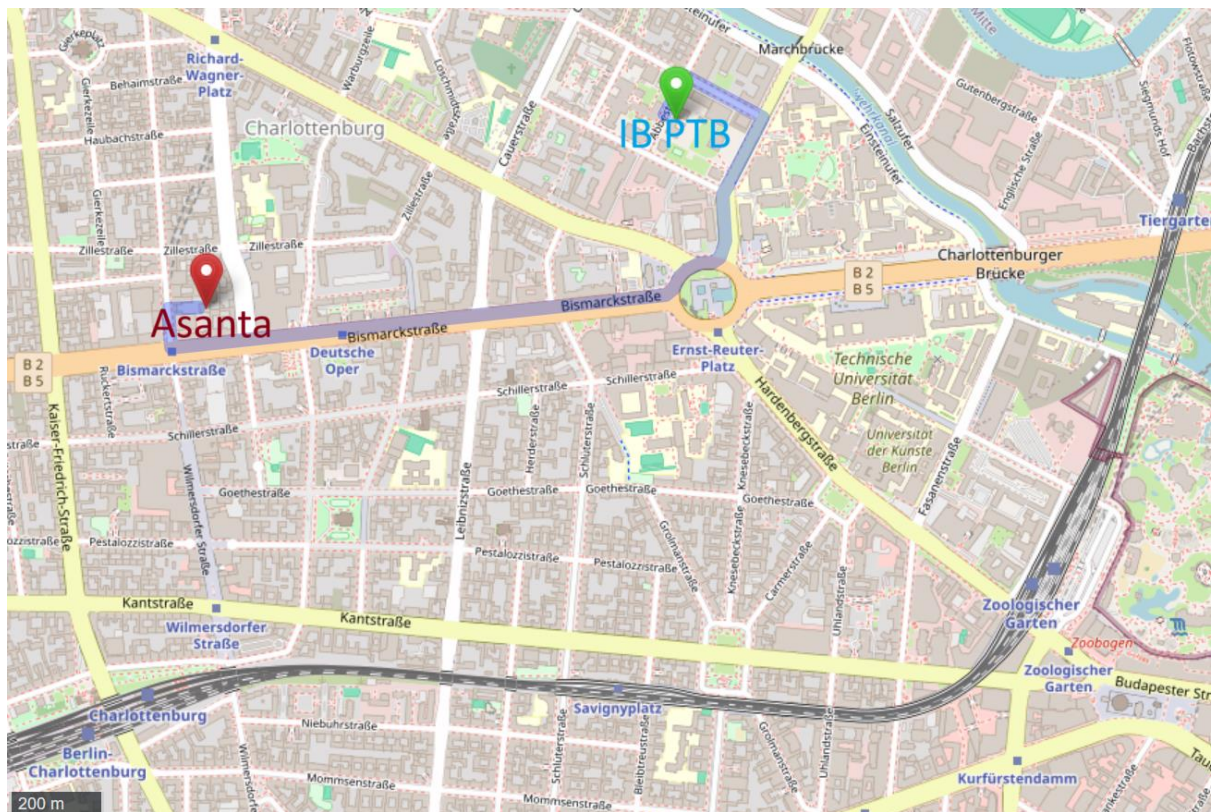
The two main locations of the GA will be the Institute Berlin (IB) of PTB and Asanta Berlin, both located in Berlin-Charlottenburg.

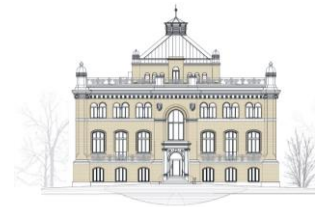

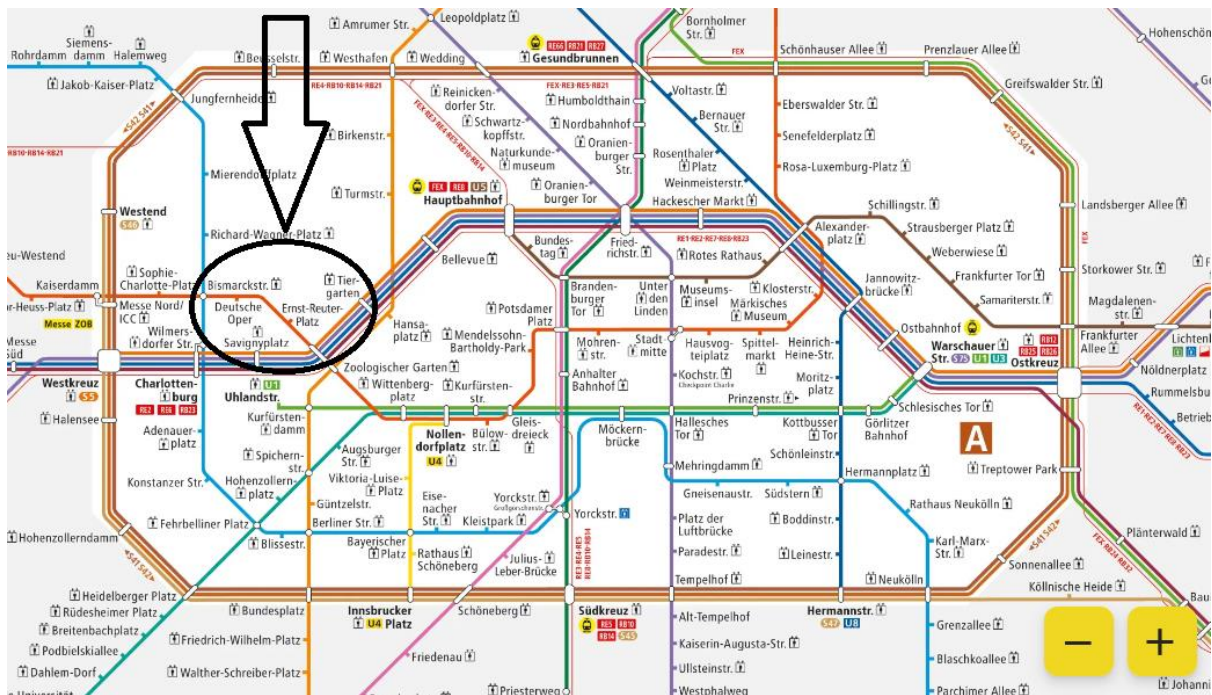
Airport Information

[Berlin Brandenburg Airport \(BER\)](#) in Berlin, Germany, is the closest airport to the PTB in Charlottenburg, about 30 km (19 miles) away to the southeast and ca. 30 minutes away by car/taxi (fastest option), 1 hour by the transit system (train) and 1 hour 15 mins by bus. 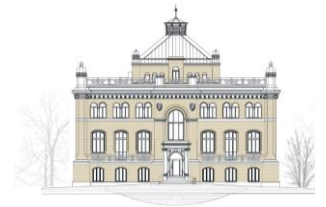
ASANTA is located near **U Bismarckstraße (U2, U7)**

PTB is a 5-10 min walk from **U Ernst-Reuter-Platz (U2)** and a 20 min walk from **S Tiergarten** or **S+U Zoologischer Garten**

Please note that there is a limited number of parking spots close to PTB, so it is recommended to use other means of transport (public transport or ride-share services).

Taxi, Uber etc.

Passengers arriving at BER Terminals 1 and 2 use the north and south taxi ranks in front of T1 on Level E0. There you will find licensed taxis. More information about taxi services at BER airport [can be found here](#).

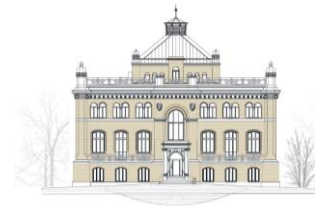
As an alternative, [Uber](#), [Bolt](#) or [FreeNow](#) can be also used conveniently for taxi services.

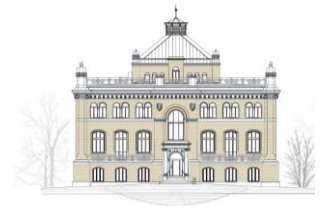
Welcome Reception on Tuesday

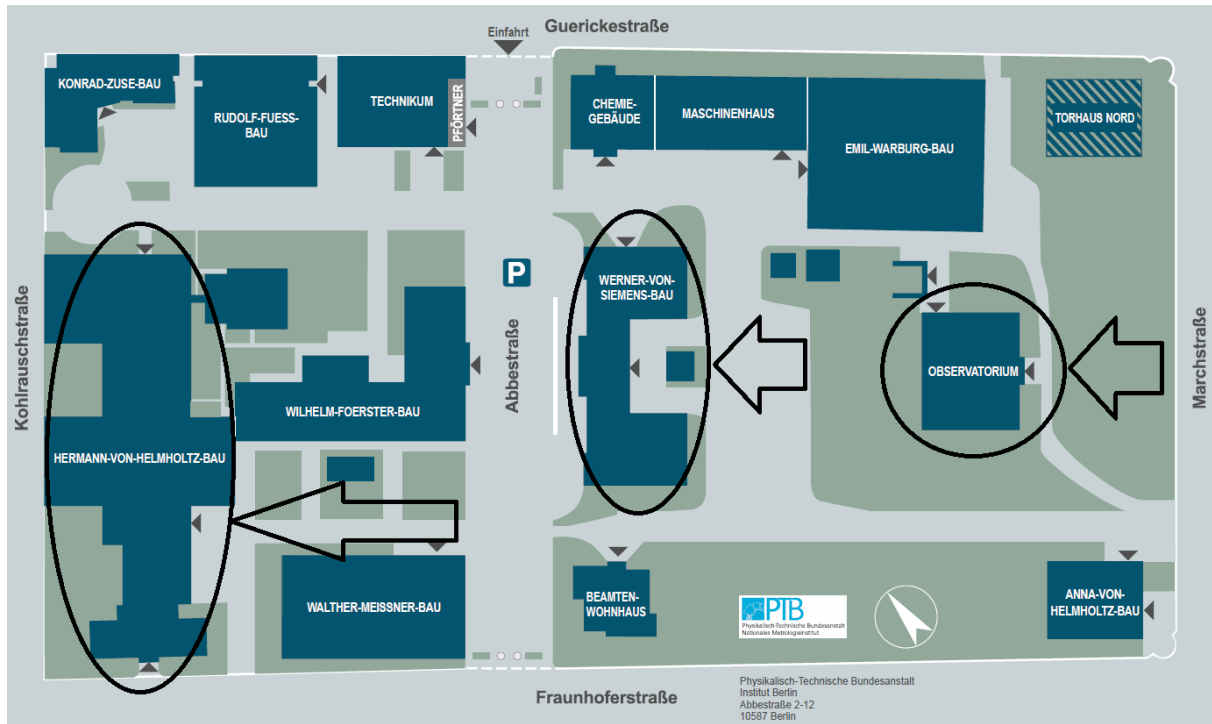
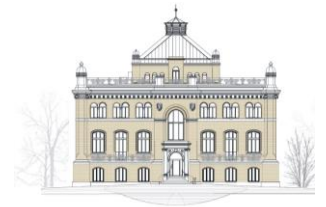
